



I took Myriam's online interior design course in 2021.



The goal was to deepen my knowledge and technical expertise in interior design and decoration to further position my interior design advice website as a reference in the French market and also to be able to work as an interior designer with my partner Anne-Sophie. I was already a journalist for a major French decoration magazine, but I wanted to have the credentials of a certified interior designer and not just a trend forecaster title.

The courses on creating decorative concepts allowed us, for example, to structure our presentations and artistic axes during product collaborations with major French furniture brands that publish our creations. Starting from a concept helps us to have a common thread for the composition of a collection and its storytelling for everything related to communication.

Having learned with Myriam's courses to carry out client briefs also allows us to be more efficient during project discovery interviews with our clients. We are thus better able to meet their expectations.

Today our website is a real reference in France, we collaborate with many brands, and our Instagram is followed by more than 110,000 followers.





After obtaining a master's degree and working in a bookstore for a few years, I decided to listen to my heart and pursue a career that I am passionate about: becoming a self-employed interior designer.


I took Myriam's interior design course at her school in Paris in 2010.

Today, I am not continuing her international adventure because I want to devote myself entirely to my real estate flipping business.


